### **Short introductory text about Bergmann Attorneys at Law:**

### **1. What is your role at Bergmann Attorneys at Law, and what does your work involve?**

Many of our clients are international, and Switzerland plays an important role in global energy, finance, and industrial value chains. **3. What key global trends are currently shaping your industry?**

From our perspective, the most significant trends include the energy transition and the rapid build-out of renewable generation, storage, and supporting infrastructure, all in an environment of geopolitical uncertainty. Our core industries – construction, energy, infrastructure - are sensitive to such uncertainty, but they also play a key role in improving crisis resilience. For us, these developments place greater emphasis on risk allocation, bankability, and dispute readiness in project documentation.

**4. How is the connection between Finland and Switzerland reflected in your or your company's daily operations?**

While we are a Finland-based firm, our daily work is highly international. We regularly advise clients with Swiss investors, contractors, or financiers in Finnish and Nordic projects. This cross-border element is a natural part of our practice and is reflected in our multilingual work environment.
